

# Diagnostic CT for Molecular Imaging Course



The VSNMT is offering places in its CT course for 2012. Approved by the Medical Radiations Practitioner's Board of Victoria, satisfactory completion of this course enables NMTs to perform diagnostic CT examinations within the context of a SPECT-PET/CT study.

## About the course

The Diagnostic CT for Molecular Imaging course has been written by clinical experts for qualified nuclear medicine technologists/scientists. It is a flexible program delivered online via the VSNMT website, and it contains the following 3 study modules:

1. Physics of CT Imaging and Dosimetry
2. CT Clinical Methods
3. CT Clinical Applications (3 week clinical placement)

Note that attendance at a practical session is required to support Module 1. This session will be organised within the first 3 weeks of the course, and will occur outside of working hours. Candidates will be informed of possible dates closer to the time of enrolment.

## Course entry requirements

1. Applicants must satisfy the academic prior learning requirements. Details of those requirements are available on the VSNMT website. (CT Course pathways 2011)
2. To complete Module 3 of the course, candidates must organise a 3 week / 120 hours supervised placement in CT. This CT placement must be organised prior to commencing the course. It must also enable you to cover / perform the CT examinations studied in Module 2 of the course.
3. A statement of support from your employer that acknowledges you need to complete both the course work and clinical CT practice requirements within the course.

## Course duration and Cost

The course commences Monday 17th February 2012 and candidates have 16 weeks to complete all modules. To be eligible for a Certificate of Completion, candidates must complete their CT placement and all assessment tasks to a satisfactory standard within the stated timelines

Course fee:

- VSNMT Member (as of 31/01/12) \$ 2200 GST incl.
- VSNMT Non-Member \$ 2750 GST incl.

Program costs includes access to the CT course website, all course notes and readings and online academic support. Candidates will be required to purchase the prescribed text.

## Applications and Selection
