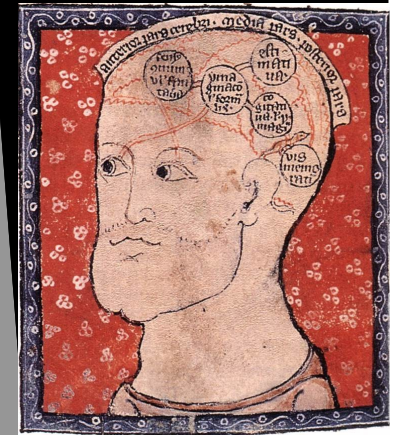

Dr Nick VARDAXIS holds a PhD in Pathology from Melbourne University. He has held a number of senior academic posts at tertiary institutions including The University of Melbourne, Phillip Institute of Technology and RMIT University. Nick is currently Director of education at Endeavor College of Natural Health
